

## REAL ESTATE TAX INFORMATION

The public records of the Collector's Office are available for your inspection and copying. We have three (3) public terminals in the hall that we will be glad to show you how to use or you may contact a local title company or tax servicing company to abstract the information for you.

If you prefer, you can mail the Collector's office a request for a duplicate of a particular "paid" or "unpaid" billing. Along with your request, please enclose a check (made payable to the Warren County Collector Fund) for \$3.00 per each parcel billing requested. Be sure and include the complete 17-digit parcel ID # for each parcel that you would like for us to abstract. Also, include the name and address of where we should mail the duplicate. If you want it faxed to you, you must indicate so in your letter and provide the fax number – otherwise it will be mailed. We do one or the other NOT BOTH!

Note: If you do not have a 17-digit parcel number or are unable to locate one on the title paperwork, you may call the Assessor's Office at 636-456-8885 and discuss with them how you might be able to obtain the parcel number from their records.

**PLEASE BE AWARE - The Warren County Collector's Office will provide the bill(s) based solely on the parcel ID # you provide. The responsibility of verifying that the bill copy you receive is the one you desire to pay rests solely with the person making this request.**
